This letter serves to confirm that **MY AFRICAN WORLD FOUNDATION** is one of the Teba Fund Trust partners in supporting rural schools' development and support initiatives in the Eastern Cape province of South Africa.

MY AFRICAN WORLD FOUNDATION has been instrumental in receiving, clearing, and distributing the educational resource materials donated by U.S - Africa Children's Fellowship (USACF). The educational materials and equipment were donated to schools that desperately needed library books, textbooks, instructional equipment, and infrastructure.

Whereas before, school libraries did not exist or were totally inadequate, across 250 primary, junior secondary and senior secondary schools. Students now have access to thousands of books and can even take them home to read. The beneficiaries of this initiative include 110,000 learners in the above-mentioned schools as well as teachers and surrounding communities.

The total number of schools in Eastern Cape is about 6,000 and the deficit is greater in the rural areas of the province. This includes amongst others, shortage of classrooms, reading materials (books), sanitation, water, and other much needed amenities. **MY AFRICAN WORLD FOUNDATION'S** objective is to create and maintain a conducive environment for learning.

Teba Fund Trust recognized the massive deficit and inequality in education between rural and urban schools and with its partners contribute extensively to the improvement of the 70.6% pass rate of matric in 2018, which was the largest improvement in the country end of year results in the Eastern Cape Province.

USACF has shipped donations to more than 900 schools in 10 African countries. Its impact has been enormous. Its success is dependent on in-country partners who share USACF's mission. **MY AFRICAN WORLD FOUNDATION** hopes to a book in the hands of every African child. They need your help.
